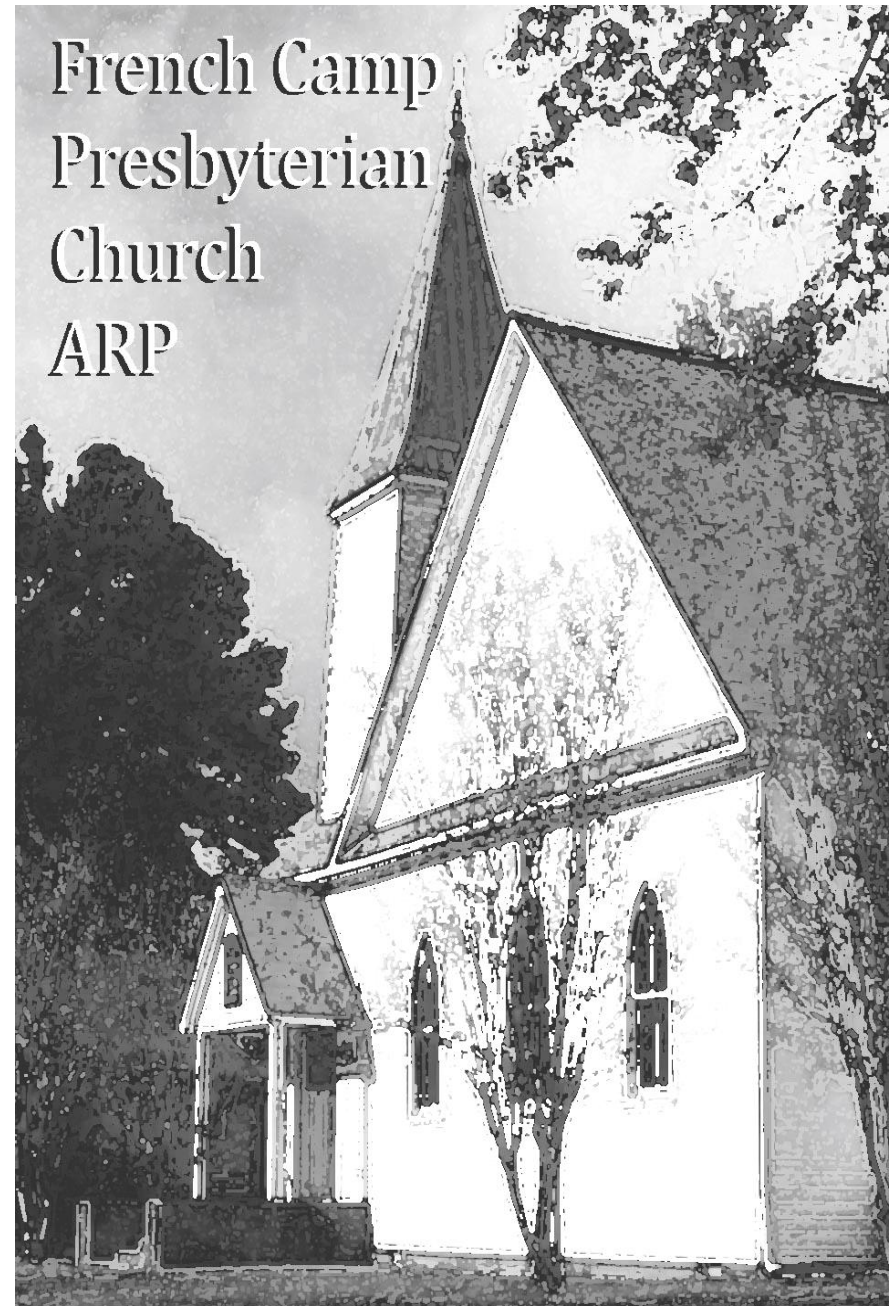
Ministry of Prayer
