### The Shorter Catechism

---

**Q. 19. What is the misery of that estate whereinto man fell?**

A. All mankind by their fall lost communion with God, are under his wrath and curse, and so made liable to all miseries in this life, to death itself, and to the pains of hell for ever.

**Q. 20. Did God leave all mankind to perish in the estate of sin and misery?**

A. God having, out of his mere good pleasure, from all eternity, elected some to everlasting life, did enter into a covenant of grace, to deliver them out of the estate of sin and misery, and to bring them into an estate of salvation by a Redeemer.

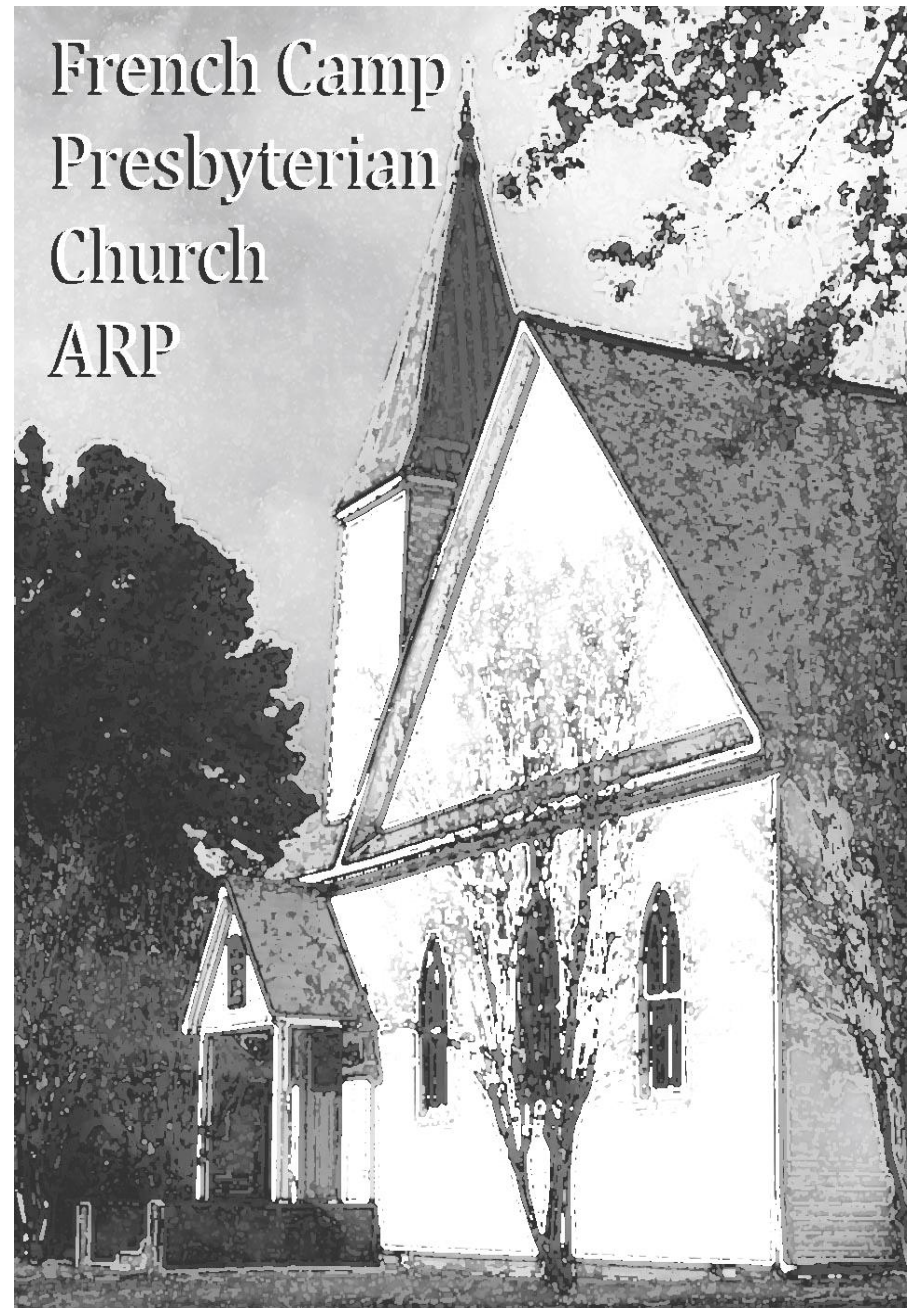
